Dear Friends,

How does your garden grow?

I wonder, if you have a garden, how is it growing?

If you have any veggies, how are they doing? Did you try anything new this year or do you stick to the same things, which seem to work well? It is really interesting to notice what plants do well in our gardens, and of course, this can change in different seasons. It is always lovely to visit other people's gardens, to talk about the joys and challenges and get ideas and even cuttings. Planting new things is an act of hope. I always feel ridiculously excited when I see a plant pushing up through the ground or sprouting a shoot.

Over the coming weeks we are going to have a chance to reflect on the 'garden' of our Benefice – notice where the signs of growth and life are. I wonder what we celebrate, what our prayers for the future might be? What are the challenges we might experience or opportunities we'd love to take a risk with?

We have a fantastic team representing our four churches who are collating a profile of our Benefice, in preparation for the appointment of our new Rector. It is part of their remit to record our thoughts and reflections. This will really help them as they create a document which captures something of how God is at work amongst us, and our hopes and dreams for the future. You will be invited to complete a specially prepared sheet of questions and return them to your Churchwardens or Parish Office. Our school pupils will also be involved in this process. We will be reflecting on these things in some of our Sunday services over the next two weeks. In the same way it is nice to chat about our gardens with others, why not meet up with a friend or neighbour and talk about these things together? You could even meet in your garden! If you are artistic, create a picture or write a poem perhaps?

The <u>most</u> important thing is that we are prayerful. Prayer enables us to glimpse where God might be at work and sense how he might be calling us to join in with his great project of love and hope. Our Four Churches Forum and Thrive Group have written a special prayer to carry us through the vacancy. We are encouraging this prayer to be used every time we gather for worship, privately in our own homes, in PCC meetings, Home Groups etc. Copies will be available in all our churches, on our website etc.

So as an act of faith and hope, let us pray,

Almighty God, we give you thanks for the many people and places that make up this part of the body of Christ.

As we work together to make Jesus known in the communities we serve, we look to you for all that we need.

Keep us faithful, generous and united in our love for you and each other as we prepare for a new beginning.

Give us courage to follow you with hope and joy in our hearts.

May we be open to change and ready graciously to welcome our new Rector, on whom we pray your blessing.


